

Exhibitor Terms and Conditions

- 1. All exhibitors shall have their site occupied and exhibits erected no later than 8.30am on the day of the exhibition.
- 2. No Exhibitor shall exhibit or maintain an exhibit which the President of Coonamble Ag Field Day Inc (CAFD) in his absolute discretion deems inappropriate.
- 3. The Exhibitor agrees to pay all charges and fees no later than the 2nd March 2020. In the event that such charges and fees are not received by the due date, the committee has the right to reallocate their site.
- 4. All exhibitors acknowledge that they are only licensees and that no right to land is given by any acceptance of this offer.
- 5. The CAFD reserves the right to refuse an Exhibitor the right to take up an exhibit site or to continue to use an exhibit site at any time without giving any reason.
- 6. The CAFD or its committee shall not be liable for loss or damage to the Exhibitors property whilst on the field day site.
- 7. If the CAFD should find it necessary to cancel or postpone the field day, this agreement shall cease to operate upon notice to that effect signed by the CAFD President and being served on the Exhibitor by either handing it to him/her personally or by post to the address above mentioned or, at the option of the CAFD, handing or offering it to any person thought by the President to be an employee, agent or partner of the Exhibitor. The CAFD shall not be liable to the Exhibitor for compensation whether on the grounds of loss of profit or otherwise in respect of such cancellation or postponement.
- 8. Exhibitors are not permitted to use amplifiers or loudspeakers.
- 9. No livestock, other than those provided or approved by the CAFD shall be brought onto the Coonamble Ag Field day site.
- 10. No machinery, vehicles, goods or other articles shall be removed from the space before 5pm on Saturday 13th March 2021.
- 11. All food distributed to patrons or other Coonamble Ag Field Day attendees (either sold or given away) must comply with Health Regulations.
- 12. Exhibitors must keep all structures, signs, displays and products within site boundaries. Damage to underground water or power lines caused by not complying with this condition will be repaired at the exhibitors cost.
- 13. Exhibitors must provide their own electrical cords which have been tested, tagged and certified by a qualified electrician as safe for use.
- 14. All exhibitors are to supply an up to date copy of their Public Liability Insurances with their booking form no later than 2nd March 2020. Exhibitors who have not provided the above certificate of currency will be excluded from participating in Coonamble Ag Field Day.
